"I am pleased to submit Estepona, Spain in consideration for a Great City award. Estepona 'the garden of the costa del sol'- lives up to its name as a charming and sustainable Andalucian city. Annually the City plants hundreds of thousands of plants, grown in City greenhouse operations throughout the streets of the City.

"2023 makes a seminal year for Estepona, years of investment by the City continue to payoff. Over the past 10+ years the City has aggressively pedestrianized the historic center, replaced busy streets with greenways, expanded dozens of kilometers of new trails including major sections of the Senda Litoral which connects many communities along Spain's Mediterranean Coast. 2023 also coincides with the City's year of biking, having hosted a leg of the famed Vuelta pan-Spain bike race in 2022- City leadership continues to focus on health and wellness.
