



Urbanism Awards 2023 nomination: Duke Street Dennistoun, Glasgow

Great Street category

Duke Street / Dennistoun received two nominations, which have been combined and edited for brevity below.

The Dennistoun stretch of Duke Street supports the thriving, working-class neighbourhood in the East-End of Glasgow. Planned in the mid-19th century in response to the city's rapid economic and population growth, it was conceived as a competitor to the growing middle-class western suburbs of the city. Its underlying DNA of place has contributed to its resilience and popularity over the years. The density of the tenement typology coupled to perimeter blocks and excellent connectivity has combined to create a place that people love to be in and around.
