# Welcome to the British Academy of Childhood Disability (BACD) – Castang Fellowship Programme

We are delighted to welcome the first cohort of BACD-Castang Fellows. The Fellowship programme is led by the BACD Strategic Research Group and funded by the Castang Foundation. The overall aims are to identify, support, and develop future childhood neurodisability research leaders.

Over the course of the programme, Fellows will:

- 1. Generate specific, agreed outputs that advance their own childhood neurodisability research programme, as well as BACD strategic research priorities,
- 2. Develop their skills in leading childhood neurodisability research,
- 3. Develop their identity and confidence as childhood neurodisability research leaders,
- 4. Develop their knowledge of research funders' priorities and expectations.

The programme will enable Fellows to generate four key outputs:

- A personal action plan and timeline for maximising and managing the BACD Castang-Fellowship, and for delivering the agreed outputs; to be generated at the beginning of the Fellowship and maintained throughout,
- A submitted external application for a research grant in childhood neurodisability; to be submitted by the end of the Fellowship,
- A peer-reviewed publication; to be under review by the end of the Fellowship,
- A poster presentation at the BACD Annual Meeting 2018.

The programme is based around: (i) interactive learning workshops and Q&As about key childhood neurodisability research topics, methodologies, and funding streams, (ii) individual mentoring from a member or collaborator of the BACD Strategic Research Group, and (iii) peer support, mentoring, and collaboration from amongst the Fellows themselves.
