Gross Motor

- 1. Walks well, starts and stops safely.
- 2. Runs carefully.
- 3. Pushes and pulls large toys.
- 4. Carry large doll or teddy-bear while walking.
- 5. Backs into small chair.
- 6. Climbs forward into adults' chair then turns round and sits.
- 7. Walks upstairs with helping hand.
- 8. Creeps backwards downstairs.
- 9. Squatting position.

Vision and Fine Motor

- 1. Picks up small sweets with pincer grasp.
- 2. Holds pencil in mid-shaft in palmar or primitive tripod grasp.
- 3. Scribble and dots.
- 4. Builds tower of three cubes.
- 5. Enjoys picture books.
- 6. Turns pages.
- 7. Points to distant interesting objects out of doors.
- 8. Beginning to show preference for using one hand.

Hearing and Speech

- 1. Jabbers loudly and continually to himself.
- 2. Attends to spoken communications.
- 3. Uses 6-20+ recognisable words.
- 4. Enjoys nursery rhymes and tries to join in.
- 5. Attempts to sing.
- 6. Obeys simple instructions.
- 7. Shows his own or doll's hair, shoes, nose, feet.

Social behaviour and Play

- 1. Holds spoon and gets food safely to mouth. Chews well.
- 2. Holds cup between both hands. Drinks without muck spilling.
- Lifts cup alone.
- 4. Takes off shoes, socks, hat.
- 5. Explores.
- 6. No longer takes toys to mouth.
- 7. Remembers where objects belong.
- 8. Imitates (eg feeding doll, reading book, brushing floor, washing clothes.
- 9. Plays contentedly alone.
- 10. Enjoys putting small objects in and out of containers.
- 11. Emotionally still very dependent.
