

## **Resuscitation Council UK Newborn Life Support Subcommittee Trainee Representative Job Specification**

This voluntary post is an opportunity for an enthusiastic paediatric or neonatal trainee to become involved in shaping Newborn Life Support (NLS) training in the UK.

As a member of Resuscitation Council UK (RCUK) NLS Subcommittee, you will be involved in the quality assurance of the national guidelines for NLS. You will be able to influence the NLS course content and training materials and bring an important trainee perspective to this process. Along with subcommittee colleagues, you will be involved in the 2021 guidelines revision and course manual update.

You will gain experience in quality assurance, liaison with other professional bodies and evaluation of resuscitation science.

You would be expected to attend 3 NLS meetings a year which are held at RCUK in London; teleconferencing options are sometimes available. Travel expenses to attend meetings are covered. The tenure of this post is for 2 years or until you finish your training.
