

Supporter FAQs

This document is for anyone interested in supporting the work and mission of the Boaz Trust. We have set out the information below with the aim of being open about who we are, the people we support, and how your donation will be used.

Are you regulated?

The Boaz Trust is a registered charity in England and Wales no.1110344. You can find our details on the [Charity Commission](#) website. We are also registered with the [Fundraising Regulator](#). The Fundraising Regulator is the independent regulator of charitable fundraising.

Are you religious?

We are motivated by Christian values and work alongside people of all faiths and no faith.

Who does my donation help?

We support people who have become homeless through the asylum process. This includes those who have had their asylum claim refused and those who have been granted refugee status. All the people we support live in Greater Manchester.

What does my donation pay for?

We will use your donation where the need is the greatest unless you specify otherwise. We provide accommodation, basic living essentials, practical and emotional support and wellbeing activities.

Your donation may, for example, go towards the running costs of a house for asylum seekers; an emergency grant for a newly accommodated client to purchase essential food and toiletries, to pay our Refugee Support Worker; office rent and administrative support allowing us to deliver support effectively.

Are you a national charity?

Our service is for people seeking asylum and refugees living in Greater Manchester. We are members of the [No Accommodation Network](#) (NACCOM) linking charities and projects across the UK who provide accommodation for asylum seekers, refugees and migrants.

How much is spent on fundraising?

In 2019/20 we invested £37,000 in raising funds to sustain our charitable work. Our total expenditure in this year was £570,836.

Where does your funding come from?

We receive funding from Trusts and Foundations and a growing number of individual supporters. Refugee clients pay an affordable rent to Boaz once they are in receipt on an income.

Do you employ staff?

All salaries are above the real living wage. In 2021 our top salary (FTE) is £42,646.

Our host families providing temporary accommodation for people seeking asylum are not paid, nor are volunteers who assist with running night shelters or take on other roles.

Do you own property?

The Boaz Trust owns one property which is used to accommodate people seeking asylum. Our office space is rented and houses for clients are leased from generous supporters or partner Housing Associations.

Does my entire donation reach Boaz?

We use different giving platforms to assist with our administration of donations. If you give online via [give.net / Stewardship](#) they will take an administration fee of 3.5% to cover their processing fees costs. [Blackbaud](#) (our single donation provider via our website) will take a fee of 2.75% + 19p.
