

# Lemsip

#### Most Lemsip contains paracetamol

Lemsip Flu 12 hour capsules contain ibuprofen. Lemsip also contains other drugs that make it easier to breathe.



People take Lemsip if they have a cold or feel like they have flu.



### **How Do I Take It?**



Lemsip is usually mixed with hot water to make a drink but there are also tablets. Ask your pharmacist how to take it.



You should wait 4 hours before taking more.

You should only take it 4 times a day.

Talk to your doctor if you are still ill after 3 days.

Paracetamol takes about 15 - 60 minutes to start working. It lasts for 6 hours.

#### **Be Careful!**




Do not take any other medicine that contains paracetamol when taking lemsip.



Talk to your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any other medication or if you are pregnant.

Do not take lemsip if you have liver or kidney problems or if you drink lots of alcohol.

## What should I do if I take too many? (Overdose)



Call a doctor or an ambulance straight away if you think you have taken too many.
