## BECKETT PARK, CHERRYWOOD

Cherrywood SDZ is located in the south of Co. Dublin, south of Cabinteely & Fovrock. A planning scheme developed by Dün Laoghaire Rathdown Co. Council will guide the development of what is effectively a new town. Beckett Park is one of the three main parks in the SDZ area, a Class I Open Space which will provide a wide range of active recreational facilities and a high-quality open space for passive enjoyment for the people of Cherrywood.

The layout of the park is dynamic, angular and geometric, with concrete paving in a variety of finishes to define spaces and emphasise place. Granite stone excavated in the course of the wider Chernywood Infrastructure project was utilised to create robust and rough sealing and retaining walls throughout the park which contrast storagly with the geometric lines of the paving.
