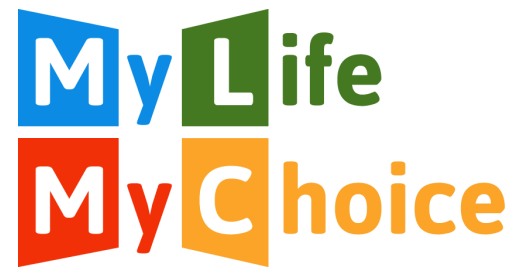


Leaving a gift to MLMC in your will

“My life is a lot better than it used to be. I am more confident, more independent, have more friends and more money.”

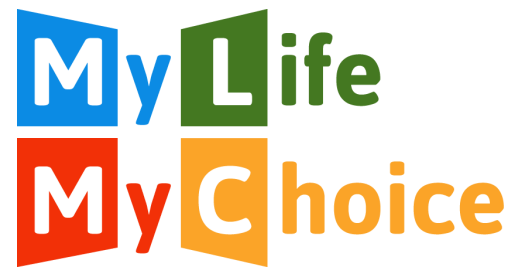


Nigel is a long-standing MLMC member and trustee. He has featured in films, gone on marches and met with MPS. He says:

Example Wording:

We recommend that you have your will drafted by a solicitor to make sure what you want happens correctly.

Here is some sample wording that you might want to use to leave a gift in your will to My Life My Choice after you have taken care of your loved ones:

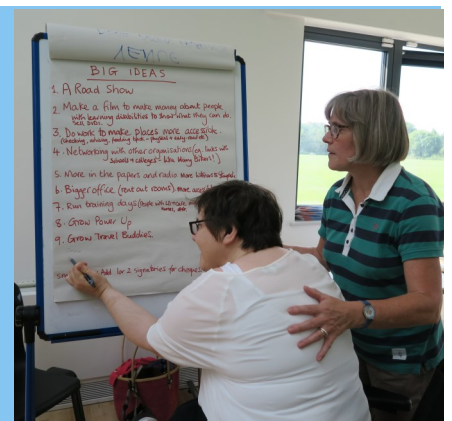


For a percentage of your estate (a residuary gift)

I give a ...% share of the residue of my estate to My Life My Choice, Unit 3, Watlington House, Watlington Road, Oxford, OX4 6NF, registered charity number 1073247 to be used for its general charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge.

For a specific sum (a pecuniary gift)

I give the sum of (words and numbers) to My Life My Choice, Unit 3, Watlington House, Watlington Road, Oxford, OX4 6NF, registered charity number 1073247 to be used for its general charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge.
