

## We realised...

- COVID has moved teaching online
- Recording teaching allows wider access to trainees in their own time
- Trainers may not have considered the risks of recording teaching

## We wanted to...

- Review opinions amongst paediatric trainers about recording teaching
- Improve confidence and security in being recorded

## So we...

- Sent out an online survey
- In a single tertiary paediatric unit
- To consultants, registrars and advanced nurse practitioners

## Current opinions on recording virtual teaching sessions

81%

Believe that recording teaching is a **good idea**

Had been recorded giving a teaching session

43%

22%

Of those recorded didn't know who would have access to the video

## We found that...

- Most paediatric trainers in our centre feel that recording teaching is beneficial
- Although many have been recorded, far fewer are aware of how their recordings are being used
- There is support for regulation and guidance on how recordings are used including where they are posted and for how long



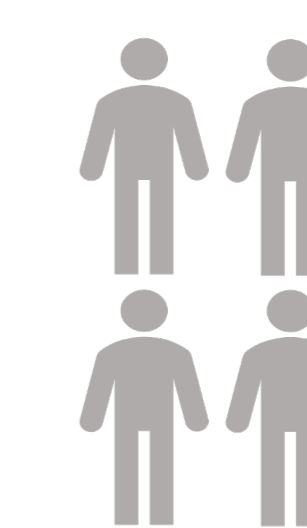
