Thoughts on Meekness

What does being meek mean to you? Is it being weak, a pushover? No! Someone who is meek is actually a very strong person. Not that they can pick up heavy weights (although maybe they can too!), but that they are strong in their character.



The Greek word for meekness also means to tame wild horses. When they are tamed, they are still strong but under control. They are strong and gentle.



Being meek is not thinking you are better than other people but valuing them, respecting them, equally. It's also about standing up for those who aren't treated equally, with strength of feeling but also with calmness. It's about standing up for what we believe to be right and just and fair. It's about listening and learning so that we understand what is the right thing to do. Are you meek - 'gentle and humble in spirit' with a

longing for justice? How can

you show this?
