35 FOR 35

We Love Stats!

SCHOOL VISITS – There have already been at least 108* in-person visits to schools so far this term. Obviously a 100% increase on this time last year!

VIDEO ASSEMBLIES – In September alone there were 295 views of our videos! Videos have been watched from as far back as May 2020, one of our very first videos. But the highest number of views have been of our latest assembly series, "Upside Down".

TOUCHPOINT is our new website and database. Since its launch on 28th June, 56* people, new to Spinnaker, have become members to have

access to all our resources. A total of 1033* people have subscribed to the resources page. (*These figures, which continually grow, were correct at the time of writing.)

Our **WEBSITE** in September alone had 560 visitors (cf. 448 in Sept 2020). Our resources pages had the most visits including 307 visits to our "Upside Down" resources, encouraging children to see life from Jesus' perspective. There have also been 60 visits to our "Let's Talk About" page which is our resource for Black History Month we produced last year. (This year's Black History Month resources were published on 5th Oct and the page has had 48 visits so far).



Finance Report from Susie

This year has seen much of our support from individuals and churches remaining in place despite the challenging economic climate, and it has been a constant encouragement to us that support for the mission of Spinnaker Trust remains strong. It is our ongoing testimony of God's provision and the generosity of the Other* 6%

individuals, churches and grant makers we partner with.

Overall income for the year totalled £130,563, a decrease of 34% from the previous year. To help redress this, we have launched our 35 FOR 35 campaign and hope to raise £35,000 in our 35th year to keep Spinnaker's wheels turning and bring in some much-needed funds to maintain the fantastic work of our team. Expenses totalled £120,175, a decrease of 14% from the previous year due to the reduced staffing levels and activity in schools. At the end of the year, there was £10,388 surplus funds carried forward.
